We remain committed to collaborating with victim advocates, law enforcement, and community partners to strengthen response systems and ensure individuals impacted by trafficking receive consistent, trauma-informed support.

2025 Impact Report

Because of your partnership, individuals impacted by sexual exploitation are not walking alone. With your support, in 2025, Re-Fined continued to provide trauma-informed programs, court advocacy, prevention training, and long-term community support across Colorado.

2025 By the Numbers

- 68 Individuals served through our programming
- 26 GAP Nights hosted
- 180 Total GAP Night attendances
- 20 women supported in our Continuing Care Community (CCC)
- 191+ CCC connections
- 37 hours of Bible study & restorative community
- 4 victims supported through court proceedings
- 36 years to life in sentencing outcomes
- 734 people trained in prevention and response (up from 85 in 2024 – a 764% increase)
- 145.6 hours of continuing education provided to volunteers

Deepening Stability Through Community



GAP Nights: Life Skills & Trauma-Informed Care

GAP Nights create space for practical life-skills development, trauma-informed curriculum, shared meals, and consistent community.

These evenings aren't events – they're anchors. Each gathering reinforces dignity, belonging, and tools for daily stability.



Continuing Care Community

Leaving stabilization housing is one of the most vulnerable points in someone's healing journey.

Women asked for more consistent connection – so in 2025, CCC gatherings increased from once to twice per month.

*Participation is voluntary.
Attendance is strong.*

That consistency tells us something important: Healing grows where trust is sustained.

Volunteer Impact

Re-Fined is volunteer-driven.

91 trained volunteers served 1,087 hours this year – a tangible expression of consistent, relational care.

We also invested 145.6 hours into volunteer development and continuing education to equip them with trauma-informed tools.

Caring well for volunteers strengthens care for everyone.

Walking Through the Legal System

Court proceedings often last 2–3 years. They require courage, endurance, and support.

In 2025, Re-Fined supported 4 victims as they navigated the incredibly challenging and traumatic legal process. Sentencing outcomes ranged from 36 years to life.



Our role is to provide a steady presence through:

- Court accompaniment
- Emotional support
- Helping individuals understand each step
- Remaining consistent through long trials



No one should face the justice system alone. With Re-Fined, they don't have to.

Prevention & Training: A Critical Expansion

Education is one of the strongest tools we have to prevent exploitation before it escalates.

In 2025, 734 parents, teens, churches, and community members were trained to recognize grooming, coercion, and trafficking dynamics.
